#### **GROUP MAIL FOR OUR FAMILY AND YOUTH MINISTRY**

We have established a group mail list for those involved in our Family and Youth Ministry. This mail list is a byproduct of hosting our own email account on our [www.Christ-in-Heath.org](http://www.Christ-in-Heath.org) web server. This list contains a means to instantly distribute information and discussion follow-ups to those who have opted into the list without having to navigate through the ever changing list of personal member email addresses.

Rhonda White has graciously agreed to moderate the group. To join, simply go to the Church Website at [www.Christ-in-Heath.org](http://www.Christ-in-Heath.org) and click on the Youth tab on main menu. From there, navigate to the Family and Youth Mail List page and follow the instructions. Once you submit your request to join, Rhonda will review it and you will receive an automated response back which you must authenticate by clicking on a special link on the message. Once that process is complete, you are free to use the list and will receive all future mailings and follow-ups.

We have a few simple rules to prevent abuse and still make it useful and fun.

1. Only those CLC members 18 and over will be approved for membership and for

posting on this list. Older children under 18 may use their parents' email addresses with their approval.

2. Anyone abusing the list for private advertising or other inappropriate personal gain uses will be removed.

3. Members may opt out at anytime by returning to the Family and Youth page on website where they joined or by emailing the moderator.

4. Individual email addresses will not be divulged by the moderator or posted on the web to protect privacy. However, we will publish a list of **family last names** that are currently on the list via the web page.

5. Members should not use the family and youth group address together with other personal addresses on the TO or CC lines of messages. Do not advertise the exact group address name to others outside the group such as Facebook or other social networking websites

6. Posted content should be limited to that of interest to the majority of members on the list.

7. Non-members (of the list) may send postings via familyandyouth at Christ-in-Heath.org . Non-member messages are subject to moderator approval prior to dissemination to the group and may take longer (note at= @)

8. Postings may contain only 5 megabytes of attachments. Please no long movies!

9. This list does not replace the LOC mail list.

10. None of the posting information will be posted on the web or on hall bulletin boards (i.e. like on a blog) and will be readable only by those on the private CLC list.
